GUIDELINES FOR FARMER'S ROOM

- The Pembina County courthouse meeting room is designated for any governmental meeting of other functions deemed necessary, educational, or advantageous for general public.
- 2. When not in conflict with other governmental functions, the meeting room may be used for other informational or educational meetings not of commercial nature, on a first come-first served basis.
- 3. The Extension Office shall keep a calendar of scheduled meetings.
- 4. The meeting room shall be designated as the "Farmer's Room" and should not be booked for any of the following:
 - a. Showers, birthday parties, weddings, anniversary celebration or reunions.
 - b. Religious services or meetings
 - c. Any meetings of special clubs or organizations that have restricted memberships other than 4-H, Scouts, Homemakers, etc.
 - d. Meeting of retail organizations, sales promotions, etc.
 - e. Catered meals except for county employee Christmas party and any other functions directly concerned with county employees or officials.
- 5. Any damages will be billed to user at county discretion.
