Program Guidelines:

- Due to program funding limitations, car seats and cribs are prioritized for low-income populations.
- Low-income populations could be identified as any of the following: WIC, WIC eligible, Medicaid, TANF, no insurance, or on Healthy Steps.
- A small fee is requested at the time of distribution to sustain the program for future participants.
- One seat per child per stage of life.
- Only primary caregivers are eligible to receive a car seat.
- Grandparents are not eligible, unless they are the primary care giver.
- Child care programs are not eligible.
- For children who are not eligible based on the above criteria, full price must be paid.
