Board of Pembina County Commissioners met at 9:00 AM in the Commissioners Meeting Room of the Courthouse with the following members present: James Benjaminson, Laverne Doyle, Nick Rutherford, Hugh Ralston, and Hetty Walker.

Chairman Benjaminson called the meeting to order.

Motion made by Nick Rutherford and seconded by Laverne Doyle to approve the April 17, 2018 minutes as presented. All voting in favor; motion carried.

Board reviewed the letter from Fred Marquardt stating his intent to retire, based on the Rule of 85, in May 2019. Motion made by Nick Rutherford and seconded by Hugh Ralston to accept Fred Marquardt's Rule of 85 retirement effective May 2019. All voting in favor; motion carried.

Motion made by Laverne Doyle and seconded by Hugh Ralston to appoint Tanya Wieler, Human Resource Director, as election inspector for the June 12, 2018 Primary Election. All voting in favor; motion carried.

Board discussed the rate of pay for the election workers for the June 12, 2018 Primary Election. One election board will be at the precinct in the Courthouse. Motion made by Hugh Ralston and seconded by Nick Rutherford to set the rate of pay at \$12.50 per hour, plus mileage, for the election board workers. Andrew Kirking, Emergency Manager/Weed Officer, presented a Fire Emergency and Burn Ban Proclamation, for open burning.

PEMBINA COUNTY, NORTH DAKOTA FIRE EMERGENCY AND BURN BAN PROCLAMATION

Dated: 01MAY2018

WHEREAS, Pembina County, North Dakota is under abnormally dry conditions; and,

WHEREAS, Pembina County has either sustained or been threatened with rural fires as of this date; and,

WHEREAS, all available resources remain committed to protecting life and property; and,

WHEREAS, the impact of fires could threaten the health, well-being, and safety of citizens in Pembina County; and,

WHEREAS, the cost of response and the inordinate equipment wear may be far in excess of available Pembina County resources.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Pembina County Commissioners declares a Fire Emergency and institution of a Burn Ban for Pembina County, North Dakota until further notice.

Any individual who willfully or recklessly violates this burn ban is guilty of a Class B misdemeanor, which carries a penalty of up to thirty (30) days in jail and a \$1,000 fine per incident, as well as the cost for fire suppression.
