The permit is to be carried on vehicle during the above mentioned movement. This permit shall be open to inspection by any officer or representative of the County Highway Department. This permit is subject to a fee if modifications are needed after issuance.

NOTICE

The hauling of loads that exceed the legal limits is a privilege granted where the property hauled cannot be stripped down if the weight as allowed by the permit is in fact more than the weight of the property for which the permit is issued, no additional property can be loaded. The weight must be as little over the legal limits as stripping will allow.

Misrepresentation by the applicant or his agent makes this permit void.

The use of the permit shall be construed as an agreement to the terms listed thereon.

Vehicles and/or combinations thereof found carrying greater axle or gross weights as shown on this permit shall be subject to extraordinary road use as stated in Section 39-12-17, NDCC.

PERMIT REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL OVERSIZE AND OVERWEIGHT MOVEMENTS INCLUDING MOBILE HOMES AND MODULAR UNITS

1. No travel on shoulders of road.
2. No travel if the visibility is poor or the highway is slippery. No travel during any adverse road conditions. No travel on muddy roads.
3. Towing vehicles must have rear view mirrors that reflect a rear view of 200 feet to the driver.
4. The traffic side of all oversize vehicles shall be marked plainly with red flags so that the clearance width and vehicle's length are readily determinable to drivers of other vehicles. Such flags shall be a minimum 18 inches by 18 inches.
5. Vehicles of excessive width, while moving where it is difficult or hazardous for other vehicles to pass, shall be provided with flag persons 700 to 1,500 feet ahead and to the rear, and as many other flag persons as are required to direct traffic safely. Mover must allow traffic to pass at each crossroad or wherever a hazard develops.
6. Vehicles are not to be parked on the traveled way under any circumstances.
7. No movement before sunrise or after sunset unless authorized on the permit.
8. No movement on roads not under the jurisdiction of the Pembina County Highway Department
9. No movement of vehicles equipped with steel tires, cleats, blocks, studs, flanges or spikes.
10. Pilot cars are required for all movements exceeding 14 feet 6 inches in width, 18 feet in height and 120 feet in overall length.
11. No Permits issued during spring weight restrictions.
12. If load exceeds 18 feet in height, mover must have written permission from utility companies to travel under overhead wires.

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENT FOR ALL OVERWEIGHT PERMITS

1. No movement on flexible pavement when the atmospheric temperature exceeds 85F.
2. Rate of travel shall not exceed 40 mph. When crossing structures with overweight loads, rate of speed shall not exceed 10mph.
3. Bridges must be crossed in the center lane at reduced speed, or as indicated on this permit.

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS FOR EARTHMOVING EQUIPMENT

1. Must have minimum 18 inch red or bright orange flags displayed on all four corners of the mobile home or modular unit, and not less than four feet nor more than six feet above the roadway surfaces.
2. When moving mobile homes and modular units with an overall width exceeding 14 feet 6 inches, including overhang, lighted flashing amber lights will be required on the front of the towing vehicle and on the rear of the mobile home or modular unit. The lights must be at least four inches in diameter.
3. Must have "OVERSIZE LOAD" sign at the front end of the towing vehicle and at the rear end of the mobile home or modular unit. Both signs must be at least 18 inches in height and at least 84 inches in length. The lettering on each sign shall be 12 inches in height and 2 inch brush strokes. The lettering shall be black on yellow background.
4. No travel if wind velocity exceeds 25mph.

PILOT CAR REQUIREMENTS

1. The vehicle must have on the highest part a sign that is a minimum 12 inches in height and 60 inches in length with the words "OVERSIZE LOAD" on it. The sign shall be yellow with black lettering. The lettering shall not be less than 8 inches high and 1 inch brush strokes. In addition, flashing amber lights shall be mounted on both ends of the sign. In place of the two alternating lights, there can be one centrally mounted revolving amber light on top of the sign.
2. There shall be radio communications between the pilot car(s) and the vehicle being escorted.
3. When not being used for an escort, all warning signs and lights must be completely covered or removed from the pilot car(s).
4. When a pilot car is required in the front, it shall precede movement by 300 to 700 feet.

This permit is subject to Pembina County regulations. The undersigned agrees to comply with all highway regulations, to take all reasonable safety precautions, and to be responsible for all personalized property damages whatsoever. Applicant further agrees to repair at his expense and satisfactory to the County all damages to highway or structures resulting from this movement such repairs to be done in such manner as the Department may elect.
