Devon Johnson – Pembina County DOT met with the board regarding drainage permits. A motion was made by Charles Thacker, seconded by Donald Kemp, by vote unanimously carried to approve the permits as presented.

A motion was made by Donald Kemp, seconded by Charles Thacker, by vote unanimously carried to approve the Drain 64 Award to Triple D Construction.

A motion was made by Charles Thacker, seconded by Donald Kemp, by vote unanimously carried to approve the Drain 64 Engineering Contract with KLJ.

A motion was made by Charles Thacker, seconded by Donald Kemp, by vote unanimously carried to approve the contract modification for Drain 79.

Zach Herrmann met with the board regarding progress on projects. The recent SWC subcommittee meeting was reviewed – TR Cutoff will not be placed on agenda until July 2020 as it was not on the water plan. Discussion also followed on the EA for Drain 81 and 82. A motion was made by Charles Thacker, seconded by Donald Kemp, by vote unanimously carried to continue with the TR Cutoff Engineering assessment as originally planned.

Discussion on the O & M inspections and SWC dam inspections scheduled for next week. A motion was made by Charles Thacker, seconded by Donald Kemp to designate Houston Engineering to represent the board on the dam inspections.

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The bids for the Snagging and Clearing project were opened. Representatives from Spruce Valley and Triple D Construction present. Spruce Valley - \$349650.00, Triple D Construction - \$167,475.00. A motion was made by Donald Kemp, seconded by Charles Thacker, by vote unanimously carried to accept all bids. A motion was made by Donald Kemp, seconded by Charles Thacker, by vote unanimously carried to award the bid for Snagging and Clearing to Triple D Construction.

Richard Webb and Robert Lundquist – NRCS met with the board and Jeff Duray – Triple D Construction regarding easements along the Drain 64 project. Russell Edgar by telephone. Edgar was in agreement to request a modified use permit for the project as long as the fence is not damaged or compromised. Lundquist and Duray will complete a site inspection in the near future as part of the process to determine favorable spoil locations and seeding.
