ANNUAL PREA REPORT AND ALLEGATION SUMMARY 2024

The Pembina County Correctional Center in 2024 housed 90 inmates. Average length of stay for the inmates was 14 days.

The correctional Center in 2024 housed 72 males. Eighteen females were booked/released or transported to another facility.

In January of 2017, the Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation enacted new jail standards, one of those standards was that all correctional facilities in the state of North Dakota are mandated to become PREA compliant.

Since 2017 all of our correctional personal have received the required training on PREA.

The Pembina County Correctional Center has not had a PREA incident in 2024, or in any other previous years.

The Pembina County Correctional Center will continue to strive for excellence and safety of all inmates and staff.
