

SPECIAL RECALL ELECTION UPDATE

A Special Recall Election for an Unexpired One Year Term for District 3 County Commissioner will be held on **November 2, 2021** in the Farmer's Room of the Pembina County Courthouse, 301 Dakota St W, Cavalier, ND. **Polls will be open from 9:00 AM to 7:00 PM.**

If you have moved since you last voted, please update your residential address on your Driver's License. You can do this by going to vote.nd.gov, clicking on the Online Address Change on the right hand side and following the instructions. A new license will not be issued, however this will update your address in the Central Voter file that is used by the Election officials and speed the process of checking voters in on Election Day. **Please have this completed by October 27, 2021.** If a voter is unable to update their current address before Election Day, then the voter **MUST** bring with them a document such as a lease, utility bill, or bank statement showing their current residential address.

All voters should enter through the rear entrance of the Courthouse. Masks and a hand sanitizing station will be available for voter's use. Once you have checked in with a Poll Clerk you will proceed to the Farmer's Room where a Judge will give you your ballot and a sealed pen for you to use while voting. **Please DO NOT leave the pen at the voting station...**it is yours to keep!!!! Voters should exit through the front entrance of the Courthouse.

Ballots returned via mail must be postmarked no later than November 1, 2021. This does NOT mean put it in the mail that day. If a ballot is mailed **ON** November 1st, there is no guarantee that it will be postmarked that same day. If mailing on the 1st, it is advised for the voter to go to a post office and ask for a hand stamp of the postmark for that day. Ballots returned via **secure ballot box or returned in person** to the Auditor's Office **must be received by 4:30 pm CT on November 1, 2021.** A secure ballot box is located in the back parking lot of the Pembina County Courthouse.

The last day the Auditor's Office will be mailing ballots will be October 27, 2021. If you would like to vote in person prior to Election Day, please contact the Auditor's Office at 265-4231.
